- 1st written public overview of what Crossroads would provide was introduced
- Meet and greet, informational lunch with ATLAS Director Jerry Kieft to explore option of becoming an ATLAS satellite and/or the structure for such an outreach agency

SEPTEMBER

- 1st board meeting, 5 founding members:
 - Review program intent, development and scope
 - Identify Executive Board (need names, address, phone, email)
 - Vote on incorporation
 - Vote on non profit status filing
 - Assign officers--secretary, chairman, vice-chair, treasurer
 - Regular meetings date and time/Email agenda and voting
- 1st family served when a board member realized need. Youth Mentoring and support casework and collaboration with other local supports

NOVEMBER

- Organizational Board Meeting: Election of Officers and Articles of Incorporation Filed with the State of Iowa
- Office space offered and accepted at Our Savior Lutheran Church basement

DECEMBER

- Received an EIN (Employer Identification Number) from Dept of US Treasury
