

# Financial Information

Promotional expenses remained very similar in 2017, with some increase after taking on publishing costs versus that being donated in 2016.

Operational expenses remained approximately the same (this category includes Office Equipment, Phone, Internet, Professional Fees, Programming fees and supplies). We have committed to keeping costs low and seeking unique ways to meet overhead costs.

Not included in these charts is the category of Wages. Being a new nonprofit, the ACTUAL wages paid versus the BUDGETTED wages Paid are very out of balance. For these initial two years, the groundwork of Crossroads has been largely volunteer time/expertise from multiple individuals.

If the budgeted amount for wages were paid, it would still be only 28% of the entire annual budget.

In order to continue this community outreach, which has clearly benefitted all ages and incomes over the past two years, we need your help! All donations are applied to underwriting direct time with the families and individuals through employing diversified staff who can commit to the unique needs presented.

Basic referral and consultation services are provided at no fee. A charge would keep low income, middle class and high-income families from seeking the supportive atmosphere and the Christian encouragement that we offer as they find solutions to a wide variety of circumstances—from

offering caretaking solutions...


