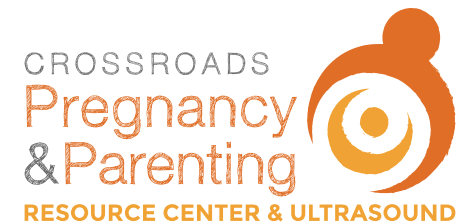

When should I take a pregnancy test?

According to Mayo Clinic, the best time to take a pregnancy test is at least one week after your missed period. If taken earlier, you may receive inaccurate results.

When should I get an ultrasound?

After you've received a positive pregnancy test, your next step is to get an ultrasound. This will reveal important information about your pregnancy to help you sort through your next steps.

Do I need to have insurance?

No, we care about your well-being, that's why all of our services are offered at no cost to you. You do not need to bring any form of payment or proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, we help by initiating the medical coverage or Medicaid process when that is needed.

Do I need to live in a certain zip code to receive your services?

No, we serve anyone who is needing support for an unplanned pregnancy.

Do you provide obstetrical services and follow-up?

No, our office will help connect you with an OB-GYN or a doctor in your area who provides obstetrical care. We are not a substitute for medical care or follow-up.

Will anyone find out about my appointment?

We care about your privacy, which is why your appointment with us is completely confidential. Our staff and volunteers understand that you have the right to tell people about your pregnancy on your time.

I'm under 18, do I have to tell my parents about my appointment?

If you are under the age of 18, you do not have to tell your parents about your appointment or bring them with you. Because the services we provide are at no cost to you and no insurance is needed, you are free to come by yourself. We encourage you to come in for a visit and discuss your situation with our staff. Usually, parents want to know what is happening with their teens and we encourage you to talk with them about your concerns. We are here to help!

Can I get an abortion here?

While we provide information and resources on abortion procedures, costs, risks, and side effects, we do not perform or refer for abortions. We do, however, serve as a safe place for you to discuss abortion and your other pregnancy options.
