



### WHAT HAS HAPPENED THUS FAR:

Early in 2023, the opportunity for adding *limited obstetric* ultrasound service to the already existing pregnancy & parenting resource program led Crossroads to find a new location that would accommodate the additional space needs.

**November 2023:** A building purchase was made by private contract with sellers; immediate modifications were made with a \$50K bank loan so transition could be timely, and include an efficient ultrasound area, offices, and conference space.

March 2024: We moved into the new location at 139 N 7th St in Denison, unpacked, and made it 'home'.

### Whole Year 2024:

- · Medical Policy & Procedure was authored for the program
- Formation of the medical team was pursued

March 2025: The Knights of Columbus groups in Denison and surrounding counties/communities presented a check for the ultrasound machine purchase, including a match from the national council for half the costs.

May 2025: A \$10,000 match from the LCMS Life Match Fund was made on \$10,000 raised by several congregations for supplies, equipment, and fees related to the ultrasound.

### WHERE THE PROJECT IS AT TODAY:

- We are waiting to confirm training dates for the three nurses who are eager to perform limited obstetric ultrasound. Our training will occur at our center, with the very machine they will use for our ultrasound days, and done by a woman whose passion for ultrasound teaching permeates every bit of her career. Her credentials are BA, RDMS. Note, this professional training is a NEW EXPENSE SS
- We are applying and planning for the professional insurance which is required for us to hold for the medical team. Note, this is a NEW EXPENSE \$\$
- We are seeking to engage more hearts toward the project's mission.
- We are seeking focused help in paying off our building and the remodel loan so

that we can more quickly and effectively return to a normal operations budget.

- We are seeking to make community provider connections and sharing our project and materials.
- We are seeking options toward **team administrative management** of the center which involves all areas of Crossroads' ministry.

### WHAT IS NEXT?

- Training early this fall for performing ultrasound! We ask for your prayers for the committed hearts and learned skill of the nurses preparing for the training.
- Our first ultrasound clinic date is getting closer! Once the training is complete, we will plan a public event to introduce the program and ultrasound area at Crossroads. Then, we will set our first clinic date and announce!

## WHAT DO WE NEED TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE PROJECT?

It is a vital time for our friends who help us SERVE LIFE to join our ministry.
