HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Call us at 712-393-4673 and we will visit with you about the needs for yourself or a loved one.
- If you are interested, we will arrange for staff to come visit you at your home to complete and assessment.
- A sliding fee scale will be used to determine our program cost.
- Highest fee assessed would be \$50 per 1 unit (1 Hour) of service.
- Verification of finances is required, and we will assist in gathering the needed information.
- The services can be prepaid or billed upon full agreement, with payment made within the month of billing. All billing will be done the first week of each month.
- Services can also be underwritten or sponsored by civic groups, churches, friends, or extended family as the recipient requests and for which the recipient is approved.

WHO ARE THE CARE PROVIDERS?

All care providers will be trained to offer personalized service that either offers a break to caregivers or practical assistance to the elderly.

No medical cares will be provided, although we can help you locate home-based medical caregiving if needed.

No transportation is provided to recipients.

Caregivers will be assigned according to similar values, needs, and personality of an individual and the availability of the caregiver's time.

Consistent scheduling is encouraged; substitution is likely to be necessary from time to time.

WHAT AREA IS SERVED BY THIS PROGRAM?

Currently we are able to provide services in Crawford County. Outlying areas will be considered on our availability status. Travel fees may apply.

WILL THERE BE FUNDRAISING FOR THIS PROGRAM?

Yes! We do plan to fundraise to help cover the cost of program provision, though we cannot make any assurances to any specific recipient or their family of adequate resources. Civic groups, churches, extended family and individual donors are encouraged to underwrite costs for a specific person or a general, unnamed recipient.

Credit balances will be tracked for specific recipients who are sponsored by a specific entity. Fundraising is likely to determine our growth of this service.

WILL THIS PROGRAM COLLABORATE WITH OTHER PROGRAMS IN THE COMMUNITY?

Yes, we anticipate working closely with other home based providers, especially medical ones since we do not cover that piece. The CoCares program was created around the need we have seen through the referrals made to us.

ARE THERE GOALS BEYOND PRACTICAL HELPING?

We know that the elderly and caregivers are very challenged by multiple obstacles—isolation, loneliness, lack of helpers, financial barriers, and physical or emotional limitations. We want to establish a working relationship with the recipients and add encouragement, hope, healthy living ideas, and Christian friendship to their lives! We won't force anything that is not desired, but would like to offer a friendly spirit to their day!
