How We Help

Difficult pregnancy circumstances implicate special challenges for most of those close to the parents-to-be. A SAFE & INVITING atmosphere is necessary for decisions regarding the pregnancy for both parents. Here are some things we can offer as we walk alongside expectant parents to help them understand options and to help meet the challenges to healthy parenting:

- Assist with decision-making & prepping for nuturing and effective parenthood
- Educate about fetal development & maternal changes in pregnancy
- Provide ongoing education, support & mentoring after birth and through the early years
- Offer education & discussions on healthy relationships, stress management, and life skills
- Encourage resolution through loss & grief on miscarriage, abortion, & high-risk pregnancies
- Provide baby items that can be earned and redeemed at our center through points earned for healthy choices and learning
- Provide referral for diagnostic ultrasounds, physician care, medical insurance needs, &/or other professional care as needed

PHASE II GOAL: \$225,000


Building payments/program development, operations & remodel & upgrade payoff
