#### SECOND GAME CHANGER

Covid magnified the needs we were serving largely through volunteers for our elderly.





Diane Vetter and Lisa Sorensen have professionally worked in a variety of backgrounds, including nursing and serving the elderly in a home aid capacity. Each of them arrived at Crossroads in very different circumstances. Once they met, they came together to 'bloom where they were planted' and authored the policy and procedure piece of CoCares. Diane manages new intakes for the program and procedural details while Lisa manages the program oversight. Without their skillful work and empathy for the elderly and caregivers, we could not be prepared to launch CoCares.

We are thrilled to be serving the first 'customers' with CoCares, and looking forward to helping with many more! Just give us a call if you have questions or would like to schedule an intake (no charge) to fully consider this terrific option. Two things mark this basic home and personal errands service as truly unique:

**1)** Because we do not bill insurance or Medicare, we can get into the homes with practical helping AND for an even larger reason: visiting and conversations! Addressing things like grief, worry, regrets, and just simple need for friendship are sometimes the larger need hiding behind the physical or practical need. We want to help with BOTH!

**2)** Neighbors, family and community often wonder how they can help an elderly neighbor or a caregiver who is weary and stressed. CoCares offers a terrific means to do exactly that because the fees can be underwritten by anyone! Amounts made to Crossroads for a specific client will be credited to the client, and amounts given with specification to CoCares program are tax deductible since we are a charitable organization.

Our informational resourcing will continue for families looking for specific information or who would like assistance with making a referral. We strive to offer encouragement and a listening heart along the way in difficult circumstances. After updating the Rotary Club via a virtual meeting regarding our work, we applied for rotary funds to specifically target the pregnancy resource center needs.

\$2500 was graciously donated to promote our work and expand our outreach through coffee! We are optimistic that we can at least double that amount again simply through the increased marketing of the whole bean and ground coffee.

A new cost to our center this year, which will be ongoing, is the stocking of the baby zone area. We anticipate that the flow will enable us to generously provide baby basics and new clothing that the parents in our program can 'buy' with the points they earn from engaging in parenting curriculum, mentoring, healthy lifestyle, and appointments that optimize their health and success.

#### These are some key donations from 2021.

**Crawford County Community Foundation** awarded \$4000 to Crossroads to apply toward the CoCares launch. What a terrific boost that gave to completing the procedural planning, training, and to offset some fees for persons who very much need the companionship and practical helping!

**Schleswig Basic Fund** shared \$861 to Crossroads to provide reimbursement for our volunteer driver, Larry Goering. Throughout the dismal times of Covid, we especially wanted to keep healthy meals coming to Schleswig Seniors, and having a consistent person popping in with the meals was a great advantage. We are grateful for the help from the Basic Funds to offset some of our costs to offering Meals on Wheels in Schleswig, and grateful to Larry for his ongoing time and expense driving the meals to Schleswig and delivering to each door!

**Immanuel Lutheran Church**, Schleswig has incorporated annual giving to Crossroads in its budget. What a helpful way to our planning and management of our programs! Individual groups within the church have also been supportive or our work through financial and in-kind gifts.

Soc & Crowford Decategorizaton Project and Community Partnerships for Protecting Children share neighborhood or community network mini grants to suitable applicants. They awarded \$450 to Crossroads toward a parenting curriculum that we will utilize with our young parents who want to grow and become the best parents they can be. Parents in our program earn points for this and other growth-related activities that set them up for success! We are grateful for this significant offset to the expense of our subscription to the parenting program!

**United Bonk lowd** pays to wear jeans! We were notified that Crossroads was drawn to be the recipient for the drawing which occurs every two weeks between all UBI sites. We really are blessed knowing that employees engage in this fun way of raising monies to go into a growing account for so many charitable causes. We plan to accept a gift of \$2,348 from UBI toward our work.



Here is an incredible blessing which was anonymously donated to us with a simple request to make it fundraise for us. Since this beauty arrived at our office, there has been some buzzing about how to optimize finding it a home who can appreciate the intricate and numerous hours of work and overall value. It is called a Batik Quilt. It is made by covering an area of fabric with a waxy substance to prevent the dye from penetrating into that area. Batik materials are a high thread count so an extra fine needle is used when piecing the bright bold colors.

After some investigation into the time and expense and value, we have decided to make it raise funds for Crossroads' work by selling chances for it. We do not have an end date because we want to first publicize it as broadly as we can. We are striving for a meaningful price that the wonderful seamstress wanted, as she donated it to Crossroads with hopes of it making money toward our ministry. Wow, what a humbling blessing to think of the hours and cost she poured into the overall 96 x 96-inch

piece that a photo hardly does justice to. Stop out to see it and if you are interested in contributing a chance!
